



PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Welcome ATRA Members!

This has been another strong and rewarding year for our Association, marked by significant growth in the number of events, the dedication of our promoters, and the continued enthusiasm of our members.

The past season saw 121 events run across Australia, a clear increase on the 102 events held last year with a total number of 21,670 runs recorded. This growth demonstrates the continued expansion of our sport and reflects the hard work of both our Board and our Promoters. The increase in events means more opportunities for competitors of all ages and levels and it shows that team roping, barrel racing and all roping events continues to gain momentum within our regions.

We were fortunate enough to welcome 3 new Promoters into the ATRA family this year, with our promoter numbers growing from 21 last season to 24 this year. We welcome Mapp's 9 Splice Ropings based in Singleton NSW, Clay and Ash Bush (with the initial help from Micheal Wilkinson and Terry Dowell) of Cootamundra Rodeo Club NSW and Mark & Jill Lyons/Shane & Jorja Iker from Rocky Region Ropers in Central OLD. Each Promoter plays a vital role in the health and success of our sport. Their willingness to take on the challenge of organising and hosting events is the backbone of what we do. Without their commitment, the scale of opportunities available to our members would simply not be possible.

The Association is also in a sound financial position, due to some careful budgeting and some very generous cash partners in 2025, with special recognition to our Naming Rights Partner - Circle L Australia, the Queensland Government, Central Highlands Regional Council, Affinity Equine Insurance, Ranchman's Saddlery, Better Beer, Stockman's Supplies, HV Power Mount Isa, Emerald Ford and Diamond T Equine.

The Circle L Australia National Finals being held at the Affinity Equine Insurance Arena is shaping up to be one of the best in recent years, with an increase in entries across all events. One major change we as the Board of Directors made this year was to remove the

2 saddles for the Opens and replace them with an increase in posted prize money. We didn't come to that decision lightly but judging by the increase of over 40 teams in that event alone it has been well supported by our competitors.

Like any growing sport, we continue to face challenges. Logistics, scheduling, and balancing the needs of different regions are ongoing considerations. The rising cost of running events is also a factor that we must continue to manage carefully. Nonetheless, these challenges are outweighed by the positive progress we are making, and we are committed to addressing them proactively.

As we look toward the coming season, our focus will remain on strengthening our support for our Promoters and ensuring they have the resources to run successful events. We will continue to encourage further youth development days, to secure the future of our sport and explore opportunities to broaden participation and improve the experience for members at all levels.

None of our achievements this year would have been possible without the hard work and dedication of so many. To our Board, who work tirelessly behind the scenes, to our Promoters who make events possible, to our Sponsors and Partners whose support is invaluable, and to our members who are the heart of this Association — thank you.

Thank you also to the Board of Directors for all your hard work and dedication. Myself and the whole Association appreciate the time and effort that comes with this role and it was a pleasure working alongside you all year.

Together, we have delivered another outstanding season, and together we will continue to build an even brighter future for the Australasian Team Roping Association.






